

# As-Built now uses Module Permissions

## Overview

Historically, the ability for users to create and edit an As-built record was managed through user functions and edit group membership. The As-Built module in CMPRO is now managed with module permissions. Details of this change are described below.

## Details

As-Built records will now be managed by control group/role permissions derived through the As-Built module. This change affects how As-Built records are created and managed.

Although not necessarily, CMPRO customers currently managing As-Built records likely have edit groups already in place that are used in conjunction with As-Built record permissions. In those cases, to facilitate the transition of the usage of edit groups to control groups associated with the As-Built module, PSA has...

- Created control groups using the same naming conventions as any existing edit groups, preceded with an “AB” to serve as easy identification of those groups.
- Created roles that use the same naming conventions as the control groups mentioned above. Users who were in these edit groups, as well as owners of Active As-Built records, have been automatically moved into these newly-created roles.
- Although the user function CREATE / EDIT AS-BUILT is still active, once PSA is assured that this change has been implemented successfully, this function will be retired.
- Changed the **Edit Group** field label on the *As-Built Part Detail* screen to **For As-Built Management**. The List of Values available here are those control groups with permissions assigned through the As-Built module.

(NOTE: the user function ALLOW PART / SERIAL / CAGE CHANGE ON AS-BUILT will remain active until further notice. Other user functions and business rules relating to As-Built not mentioned specifically herein will also remain intact).
